Back to School

Schools in Kenya reopened on January 4th after being closed since March 2020 due to the coronavirus. We sent 129 students back to classes including 3 preprimary, 87 primary, 31 secondary, and 8 vocational school students. We paid first term school fees and equipped all students with new uniforms, shoes and school supplies.



Providing food for the needy Families are still struggling to eat. The coronavirus continues to impact the ability of people to earn money. We have been providing food to help fifty needy families each month. We provide families with

beans, rice, wheat and corn flour, oil, milk, and soap.



More **Tutorial** Sessions

The children have lost almost a whole year of school due to the pandemic and we are doing our best to help them not fall any further behind. We continue to run tutorial sessions for the secondary school students and are now recently able to include 7th and 8th graders.



New Library **Books**

We restocked our entire library of study books for the students. The library provides review books and reference materials to help the students in their studies. Our students cannot afford these types of learning materials. The HOPE library provides the only access they have to these kinds of supplemental books. These materials are critical to the academic success of our students.
