Here's what you enabled us to accomplish.

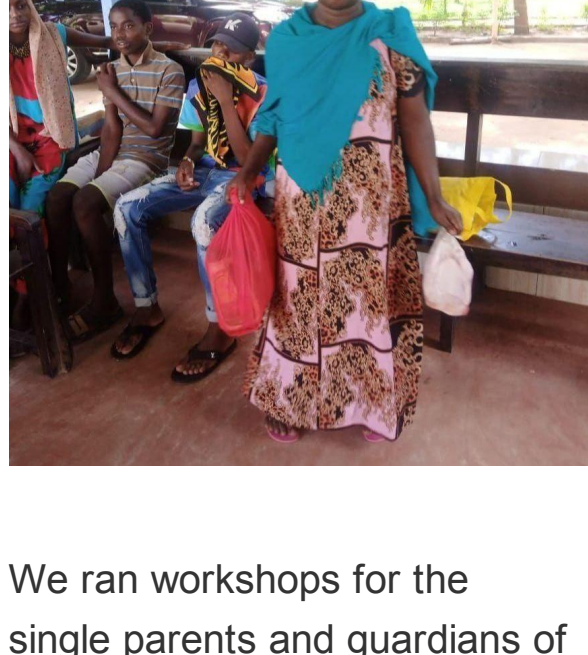
Learning with Digital Technologies

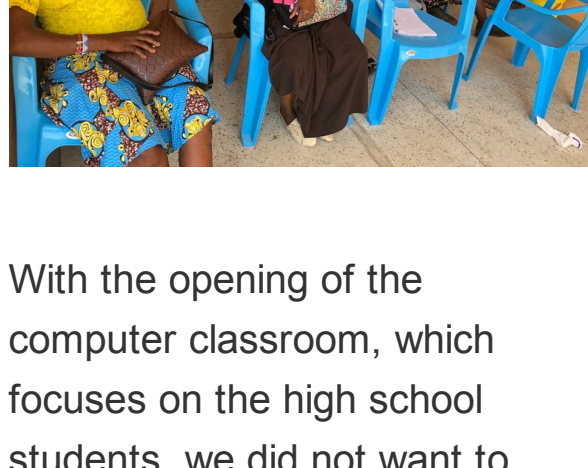
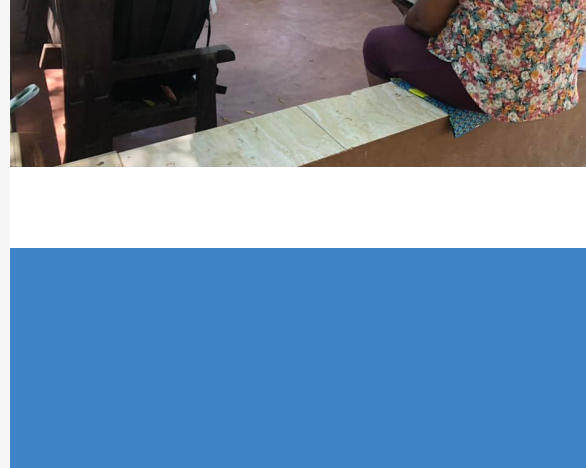
Helping the Hungry

We continue to give out food monthly to help needy families. On Christmas Eve, we provided our HOPE families with additional food for a nice Christmas meal. This included a fresh whole chicken, accompaniments and dessert.



Life Improvement Workshops

We ran workshops for the single parents and guardians of our students on the topic of gender based violence. Over 40% of women and girls in Kenya face physical and sexual violence, many times occurring in the home. Sadly, a number of our HOPE students and family members are victims of this tragic abuse.



Nicer Learning Environments

With the opening of the computer classroom, which focuses on the high school students, we did not want to forget about the primary school students. We decided to outfit the office with additional shelves and desks to make it a study hall for the primary school students to use during tutorial sessions.



Time for New Sets of Threads

At the end of the year, we began having new uniforms made for all our students. All students in Kenya, in both public and private schools, are required to wear uniforms with each school having their own colors. We have several tailors make the uniforms for our students and each student had to be measured. Most have grown a lot since last year!

We try our best to provide fun activities to give the students a chance to relax and have some fun.
