



In the second quarter, we brought five new students into the HOPE Project – on top of the ten from the first quarter. We paid second term school fees for over 225 students. We continued to give out food each month to over 50 needy families and supported several families with rent assistance. We provided seven beds and mattresses to families who were sleeping on the ground. We ran weekly Saturday tutorial sessions and held workshops with the parents and guardians of our students across our two locations.

Helping More Children

There is nothing better than being able to assist more children with their education and help to improve their home lives. We admit students based on need and most of the students we accept were not in school due to financial difficulties. We brought five children into the project in the second quarter – Darling, Natalia, Ismael, Marium, and Athman.



Back to School for the Second Term

We paid school fees for over 225 students for the second term of the school year. We have students ranging from preprimary through high school, vocational school, and college. Education is the key to unlocking a better future for our children.





Giving Children a Place to Sleep

We gave out seven beds and mattresses, along with sheets and pillows, to our students and their families in the second quarter. These children and their families were sleeping on the ground.





Helping Our Children Learn

We provided over 160 bags of food to needy children and their families during the second quarter as part of our monthly food distributions. Food prices in Kenya continue to rise making it harder and harder for families to survive.



Partnering with our Parents and Guardians
